Hot Water

Tap water temperature should be set at 120 degrees Fahrenheit, the "warm" or "low" setting on your water heater. For children and senior citizens, a tap water temperature between 95 and 100 degrees Fahrenheit is suitable. Never leave a small child alone in a tub where he or she can accidentally turn on the hot water.

How to test your water temperature:

1. Run the hot water for five minutes.
2. Put a reliable thermometer that registers at least 150 degrees under the water stream.
3. If your water is more than 125 degrees, lower the thermostat on your water heater.
